Performances will take place at DiMenna Center for Classical Music, 450 West 37th Street, New York, NY 10018, and the Carnegie Hall, 881 7th Avenue, New York, NY 10019. Our faculty members will perform concerts on July 1st. Besides our faculty concerts and open master classes, the New York Piano Festival offers piano lessons for students of all levels and ages. All students will have the opportunity to perform on July 1st, and receive HD DVD of their performances and certificates of participation.

New York Piano Festival is a great learning experience in a positive and friendly environment. Its goal is to bring together musicians of all ages to share the joy of music to motivate and develop their technical and artistic skills. Students will have the opportunity to meet great performers and talk with them, to ask for professional advice. Students will be able to learn not only from highly qualified teachers and performers, but also from one another.

## **Eligibility**

\* NYPF is accepting applications until **June 12th**. The application fee of \$150 is non-refundable and includes two tickets to all our concerts including receptions.

\* There is no age or level limit, beginner, advanced or professional levels are welcome.

\* Participants will have the opportunity to perform in our student concerts on July 1st. Students may perform in master class with same or different repertoire.

\* Our lessons will focus on basic approaches of technique and interpretive issues. Our goal is to supply and enhance the basic tools for piano performance, bringing the student's talent, personality, and prior training to a harmonious blend of artistry. Lessons take place either at the teacher's studio or the student's home. The lesson fee is \$80 per hour. There are no additional tuitions or fees for the New York Piano Festival.
